Winter clothing

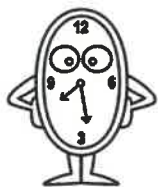
As the weather is now getting colder please can you ensure your child is dressed appropriately and warm. It may look lovely out of the window but it's quite chilly when they're outside!
