### In Class this week –

#### Holly Class

For our topic In Holly class this week we have been learning about the weather and read Elma and the Rainbow and also painted rainbows. In maths we've been looking at ordering and comparing numbers.

#### Oak Class

In Oak class this week we have been looking at states of matter - solid liquids and gases, we've started to read the Fox and the Ghost King as our class read and in topic we have been looking at where in the World is the UK and where in the world is Waltham. All the children in Oak class have been given a maths book to support them with their homework and maths learning journey.

#### Sycamore Class

#### Coats, Gloves and Hats


## Café Church
