




	<p align="center"><u>Teams 365</u></p> <p>Schools may incorporate other platforms but Microsoft Office 365 Teams is our main base of communications, file sharing and lesson delivery. This is monitored carefully.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>SHORT TERM PLAN</u></p> <p>All classes / year groups have access to a short term plan of lessons and activities which pupils can access straight away and work independently without school support. This provides learning for the short time whilst teachers prepare and upload lessons and teaching to Teams.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>Core learning Grab Bag</u></p> <p>All classes will have an overview & lessons for very important core learning that children should re-visit. Some of these will be placed in their grab-bag, to be taken home when the bubble closes. Repeating learning and retrieval practice is a very important part of remembering.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>Timetable</u></p> <p>All classes will have timetable of teacher led and independent learning. Learning at home isn't optional and all best endeavours & partnership working must keep children on track. Children must register with teachers every day. Teachers are available to learners from 9-3pm Monday-Friday.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>Blended Learning</u></p> <p>Blended learning can incorporate a variety of methods and each school will approach this differently. Most children will access teacher led learning and independent working away from a computer, like they would in school.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>SUPPORT</u></p> <p>Support can be offered by email to the office or Seesaw – they will endeavour to reply within 24 hours. Teaching assistants will regularly check in with pupils and parents about their learning.</p>
	<p align="center"><u>REMOTE LEARNING WEBSITES</u></p> <p>As well as the input from the teacher, parents and pupils will be signposted to a range of other websites and platforms where high quality learning and support can be accessed.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">    </div>
	<p align="center"><u>E-safety</u></p> <p>Safeguarding is everyone's concern & a key priority. Staff will monitor class chat sessions and set known 'safe' online activities; children must report concerns immediately and follow the e-safety rules; parents must supervise online learning activity.</p>
